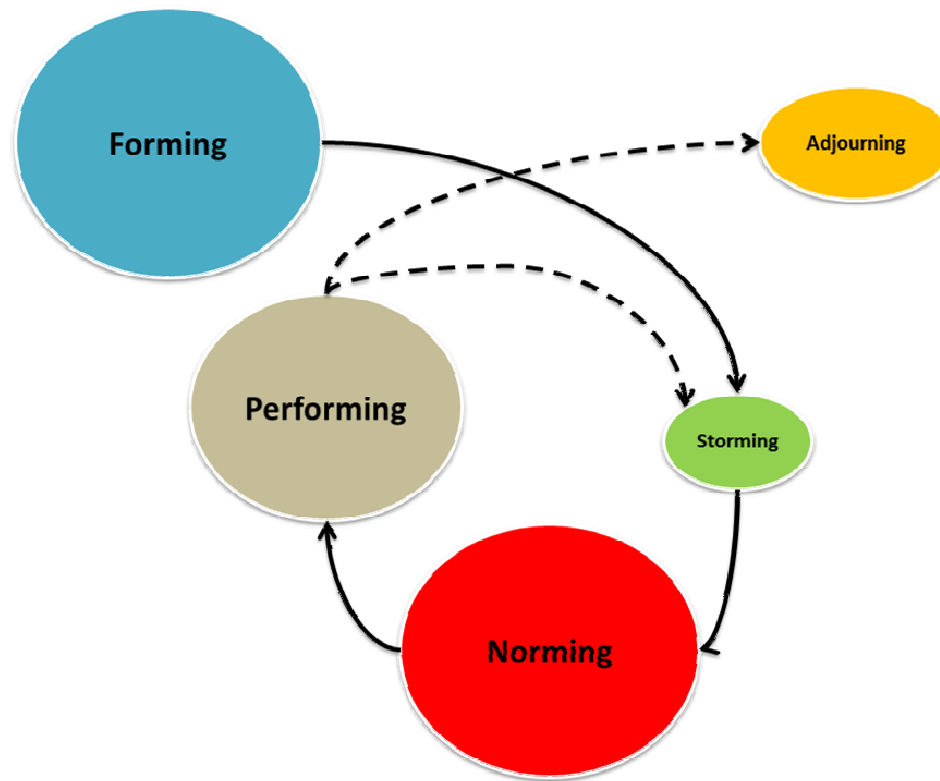
Team Building Process in a standard environment

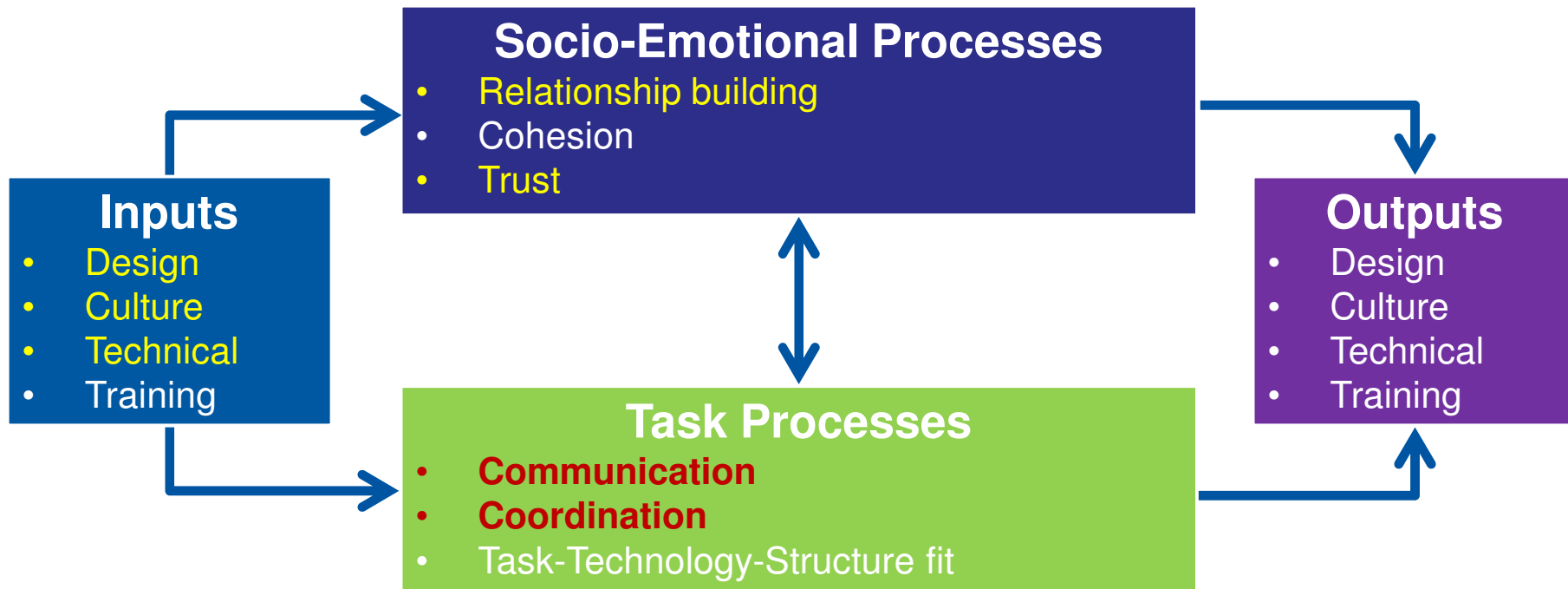

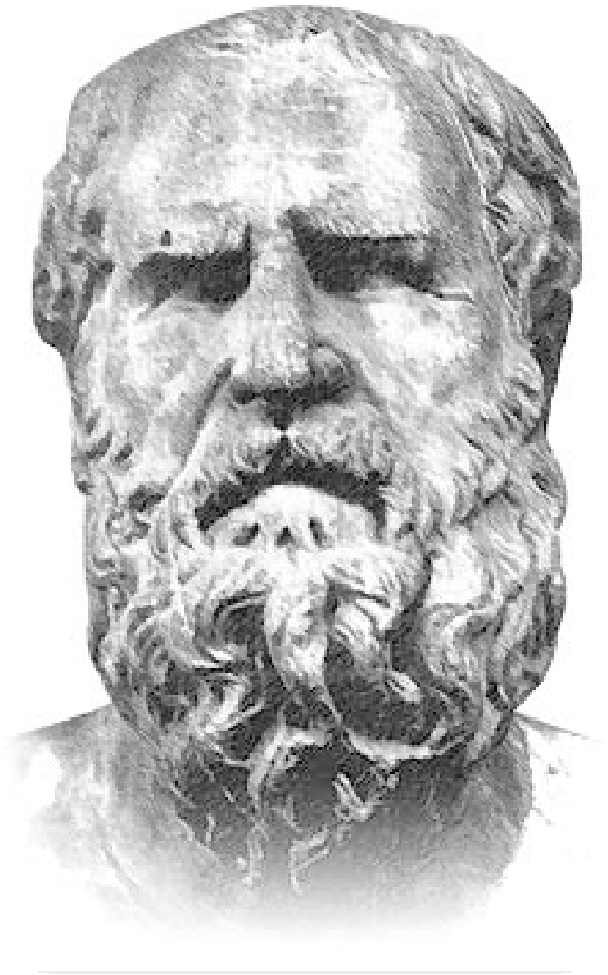
